SBE Minutes Summary:

GRAD-005: Special High School Diplomas for World War II, Korean Conflict, and Vietnam Era Veterans. "The Board voted unanimously to approve the slate of consent agenda items as presented." GRAD-005 was among the items approved via Consent Agenda.

Expands current policy to include individuals who left high school to join the military during the Korean Conflict and Vietnam Era. Note: Policy coding changed since approval in 2016.

Relevant Section of Statute:

(29) To Issue Special High School Diplomas to Veterans of World War II, Korea, and Vietnam. - The State Board of Education shall issue special high school diplomas to all honorably discharged veterans of World War II, the Korean Conflict, and the Vietnam era who request special diplomas and have not previously received high school diplomas.
