SBE Minutes Summary:

UNC Board approves new policy to award college credit for AP Exam scores begins fall 2019.

On July 27, 2018 The UNC Board of Governors voted unanimously to approve an AP Credit Policy in regular session

-It is in the best interest of North Carolina's students that the University of North Carolina's (UNC) constituent institutions award undergraduate credit on the basis of AP exam scores in a uniform manner, and that potential students and their families receive clear and consistent information regarding this awarding of undergraduate credit.

-UNC System constituent institutions shall award appropriate credit to undergraduates who have earned a score of three or higher on one or more AP exams, as defined in the Regulation on Awarding Undergraduate Credit on the Basis of Advanced Placement Exam Scores, Section 700.1.10[R] of the UNC Policy Manual.
