### SBE Minutes Summary:

SBE Policy Amendment - LICN-003: Licensure testing Requirements

"It is recommended that the State Board of Education approve these policy changes." PASSED

In 2019-2020, all candidates seeking initial licensure must submit edTPA or PPAT pedagogy assessments for national scoring at which time the scores become consequential for licensure. Beginning on July 1, 2018, a candidate will be exempt from the Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) assessment requirement if the candidate can produce evidence of a passing score on a nationally scored edTPA or PPAT assessment.

LICN-003 was amended in April 2018 and further amended in June 2018.
