SBE Minutes Summary:

SBE Policy amendment - LICN-001: General Licensure Requirements

"It is recommended that the State Board of Education approve the policy amendments for LICN-001."-
PASSED

Teachers who fail to meet their licensure requirements and whose license will expire June 30, 2018, will be issued a permit to teach for the 2018-19 school year. This permit will only be good for one year and will allow these teachers to pass any licensure requirements that were outstanding and then return to an initially licensed teacher license.

115C-296 Section 8(a)

115C-296.8 through 115C-296.13: Repealed by Session Laws 2017-189, ss. 2(a)-(f), effective July 27, 2017, and applicable beginning with the 2017-2018 school year.
